



Internal Assessments

Graded *internally* by the classroom teacher during the IB course (either Y1 or Y2)

Random samples sent worldwide to IB examiners for moderation of scores, feedback provided to teacher

Various formats: oral, essay, research, visual, product, lab, performance

External Assessments

Timed, standardized IB exams given in May at end of course (year 2, nominally)

2-3 parts for most exams, largely constructed response

All exams sent world-wide to IB Examiners for grading

Scores communicated to school and students in July after the exams
