SUBJECT	CREDIT REQUIREMENT	COURSE REQUIREMENT
English	4	Lit & Comp I Lit & Comp II Plus 2 additional English Credits (American Lit, World Lit, Multicultural, AP/IB/DE, etc.)
Math	4	Algebra Concepts & Connections Geometry Concepts & Connections Advanced Algebra Concepts & Connections Plus, one additional Math Credit
Science	4	Biology Physical Science or Physics Chemistry, Earth Science, or Environmental Science Plus, one additional Science Credit
Social Studies	3	American Government World History US History Personal Finance & Economics
Career Tech/ World Lang/ Fine Art	3	Students must take a minimum of 3 credits in CTAE, Fine Arts or World Language. <i>*Students seeking admission to a four-year college or university in Georgia must take a minimum of 2 units of the same language.</i>
Health / Personal Fitness	1	Health (.5 credit) Personal Fitness (.5 credit – waiver available)
Electives	4	4 additional credits are required from the subject areas listed above

Promotion Requirements for high school students include earning a specified number of credits by passing core subjects like English, math, science, and social studies, along with CTAE/Fine Arts/World Language and elective courses.

Promotion Requirements:
 To move from 9th to 10th grade = 5 credits
 To move from 10th to 11th grade = 11 credits
 To move from 11th to 12th grade = 17 credits
 To move from 12th to graduation = 23 credit
